Today, so many forces in our culture threaten these treasures. Churches with schools often struggle to make ends meet. Tuition costs can hinder parents from enrolling their child in a Lutheran school. Fewer and fewer churches have vibrant Sunday schools and Bible studies for all ages. Schools close, and very few new schools are launched.

The result? Many churches in the LCMS, a tradition within American Christianity recognized for generations as a teaching church, are simply not teaching much anymore. We need to address the above now!

The purpose of the *To All Generations* campaign is to generate funds for Christian education at all levels and ages for the local congregational ministry. Overall goals are to:

- Strengthen existing schools and plant new ones
- Identify marketing and advancement strategies for Christian education
- Increase Biblical literacy among children and adults
- Strengthen leaders for the effort
- Promote a voice for parental choice in education in the state legislature
- Offer assistance in establishing day cares and preschool ministries
- Strategize ways to become more intentional in reaching young families

Under God's grace, we must become more intentional in reaching everyone with the Good News of Christ. As the above goals are addressed, we pray that our efforts will be blessed with even more contact in sharing Jesus' saving message.



To cultivate a stronger commitment in Christian education, the Minnesota South District is embarking on a special appeal with specific Christian education initiatives in mind. The *To All Generations* campaign offers a bold plan which can touch every congregation, member, and friend from early childhood to adult. New funds will become available for new and enhanced educational ministries. Rooted in the Scriptures and in our history as a Synod, these initiatives view the future confidently. Rejoice with us and pray as we move forward with these initiatives, seeking to strengthen Christian education across our District and "to all generations."



Funds will provide seed money in the form of grants enhancing the quality of education ministries in the Minnesota South District through innovative processes, leadership development, and collaborative efforts. We want to support ideas utilizing new technology and online networks focused on Christian education. Specifically, grants will be allocated in the following areas:

 Enhancing the Quality of Lutheran schools (birth-high school)

Individually and cooperatively, schools can apply for grants that inspire transformative education innovation. Proposals may include, but are not limited to, ideas that expand services, utilize new technologies, or systemically change the way schools operate.

- Encouraging Opportunities in Parish Education
 Congregations can create and expand educational
 opportunities focused on Biblical literacy, catechesis, family
 ministry, young adults, immigrant populations, home school
 families, vacation Bible school, or tutoring. We invite all
 other creative options!
- Planting New Schools and Early Childhood Centers

 A special funding appeal will provide start-up funds across the district for launching new educational ministries or significantly expanding those which already exist. Just as the Synod rejoices in new school starts in Shanghai and Vietnam, the MN South District will find shared joy in every launch or expansion of a new school or early childhood ministry.
- Supporting Educational Leadership
 Often a pastor or educator will see an intriguing conference
 or course of study and not enroll due to lack of funds. Here
 we will assist in tuition scholarships for our educational
 leaders seeking continuing education.
- 2. Develop Unified Marketing Strategies

 We believe that our Lutheran schools and educational ministries in the LCMS are still some of the best-kept secrets in many communities. Our hope is to fund a collaborative marketing strategy for school, early childhood, and congregational education ministries across our district, presenting LCMS Christian education in brief, "Hallmark-style" vignettes for use as ads on radio, television, and online.
- 3. Increase Efforts toward Parental Choice in Education
 In order to stabilize the finances of our schools and the congregations supporting them, we must actively engage in the public square to secure equal treatment by the state of Minnesota for those parents who choose a Lutheran education for their children. Funds here will encourage our members in pressing for such equality through the exercise of their own citizenship. We will engage our legislators through advocacy organizations such as OAK (Opportunity for All Kids).

QUESTIONS ABOUT GOALS & FUNDING

WHAT ARE THE FINANCIAL GOALS?

Our goals are to:

- Continue to increase our support for the ongoing ministries in our church and District
- Present gifts of \$3,000,000 in initial cash gifts and/or three-year commitments toward the Christian education initiatives

We have received strong indication for support of the *To All Generations* capital campaign. Based on recommendations, the following goals are possible, all with the Lord's blessings.

Recommended Goal: \$1,500,000 Challenge Goal: \$2,250,000 Celebration Goal: \$3,000,000

HOW ARE GIFTS GENERATED?

We rely on the power of God's Word to motivate God's people in giving through the *To All Generations* capital campaign. Resources will be shared with the local congregation during the effort. Leaders will have options on how best to distribute material with members of their congregations.

HOW WILL TO ALL GENERATIONS CAMPAIGN UNFOLD AT THE CONGREGATIONAL LEVEL?

Congregational members are asked to pray and consider a 3-year promise gift or a one-time gift to the *To All Generations* campaign in the following ways:

CONGREGATIONAL GIFTS

Our campaign consultants, Cornerstone Stewardship Ministry, will offer assistance to District congregations for the purpose of generating financial gifts for the *To All Generations* campaign and the local church ministry. This will be a wonderful opportunity for congregations to increase overall first-fruit giving for local ministries.

INDIVIDUAL GIFTS

For those who wish, gifts may be made to the *To All Generations* campaign on an individual basis along with our current and past supporters. Gifts given to the MNS District will be applied directly toward the Christian education initiatives.

MY JOYFUL, GENEROUS GIFT: WHAT IS IT?


You may ask, "What is it that you would like me to consider giving so we can achieve our goal and proceed with our ministry plans?" The answer is simple ... Your joyful generous gift!

DECIDE — The Lord Jesus is there to help and guide your decision to give and the amount to invest in Christian education. Our faith helps us believe that it is a privilege to support the work of gospel ministry. Whatever amount you decide to give in faith over the next three years is a gift that pleases God. It is a gift that will reach many through our gospel ministries.
